Uniform: The uniform is approx. \$100 and consists of 1 white jersey, 1 green jersey, 1 white short, 1 pair white socks, and 1 black training jersey. We strongly urge parents to purchase uniforms large enough to allow for growth.

Typical Season:

Practice: Teams practice twice a week for roughly an hour and a half. Additional technical training nights will be scheduled at later date.

Games: Teams play 6 - 8 league games per season (Spring and Fall) which consists of games against teams from other clubs in Central Illinois (Springfield, Champaign, Bloomington, Charleston, Morton, Pekin, Peoria). The majority of these games will be double headers -- two games on a Sunday afternoon. Weeknight games may also be scheduled at the lighted MidState Decatur Soccer Complex.

Tournaments:

Players typically attend two tournaments in both the Fall and Spring seasons. Older teams (u13-u19) may attend additional tournaments at the discretion of the Coach and Director. Typically there is no more than ONE OVERNIGHT TOURNAMENT PER SEASON. Local tournament – i.e., Champaign, Bloomington, Springfield, Morton, Peoria
 Overnight tournament – i.e., Indianapolis, Chicago, St. Louis
