Uniform: The uniform is approximately \$100 and consists of 1 white jersey, 1 green jersey, 1 green shorts, 1 pair white socks, and 1 black training jersey. We strongly urge parents to purchase uniforms large enough to allow for growth. This same uniform will be used two seasons: Fall 2022 through Spring 2024.

Typical Season:

Practice: Teams practice twice a week for roughly an hour and a half. Additional technical training nights may be scheduled at Coach’s discretion.

Games: Teams play 6-8 or friendly league games per season (Spring and Fall), which consists of games against teams from other clubs in Central Illinois. The majority of these games will be double headers – two games on a Sunday afternoon. Weeknight games may also be scheduled at the lighted MidState Soccer Complex in Decatur.

Tournaments:

Players typically attend two tournaments in both the Fall and Spring seasons. Older teams (U13-U19) may attend additional tournaments at the discretion of the Coach and Director. Typically, there is no more than ONE OVERNIGHT TOURNAMENT PER SEASON. Local tournament – i.e., Champaign, Bloomington, Springfield, Morton, Peoria, etc. Overnight tournament – i.e., Indianapolis, Chicago, St. Louis, etc.
